Personal

Vocational - Missions

- 1. Receive and assimilate mission teams. This includes, but is not limited to, preparing an orientation for students/leaders.
- 2. Aid in shower plans at church member's homes.
- 3. Travel with the team in the afternoons to do local or regional outreach at the discretion of the Director of Communications.
- 4. Lead and orchestrate FBCS' Parade & Palooza.
- 5. Work with the other interns to imagine, create, and build the July 4th float.
- 6. Lead and orchestrate summer activities (VBA's, Basketball Camps, et cetera) including registrations, schedules, and class sizes along with any other duties pertaining to summer activities.

Video & Audio Production:

- 1. Assist the Director of Communications in the production, filming, editing and publishing of Sermons in video form for the FBC Sudbury Website, and various social media outlets.
- 2. Assist the Director of Communications in the production, filming, editing and publishing of videos for special events and occasions; e.g. VBA Parent Night, VBA & Basketball Clinic Promotions, 'Super Six', Mission Trips, Gospel Stories, Know Your Neighbor, et cetera.

Social Media & General Communications

- 1. Work with the Director of Communications to develop new ways to promote events, and share the mission of the church through the use of social media.
- 2. Help create communication strategies to market, inform, and promote teaching series, big events, and other campaigns assigned.
- 3. Assist the Director of Communications in managing content on the FBCS website.
